Ms. Peters took criticism very well and always used it make herself an even more effective educator. She has developed her diagnosis skills in addressing musical problems to a high level, and she always goes an extra mile to make the teaching environment pleasant and conducive for optimal learning. I was especially impressed with her ability to relate with young students and motivate them to perform musically and with enthusiasm. In the short time that she was here at SFA, Ms. Peters built up an impressive studio schedule of piano students both in Nacogdoches and in Lufkin.

After graduating from SFA, she has already built up a studio of over 40 students in a suburb just outside of Houston. Ms. Peters continues to also serve MTNA as the Festival Chairperson for her local TMTA association.
